

THE FIVE REFORMATION 'SOLAS'

The Reformation case against Rome.

1. SCRIPTURE ALONE (*sola scriptura*)

The contrary: Scripture + Church dogma and tradition

The Bible: Isa. 8:20; Mk 7:6-13; 2 Tim. 3:13-17; 2 Thess. 2:15.

2. CHRIST ALONE (*solo Christo*)

The contrary: Christ + Mary + saints + pope.

The Bible: Matt. 11:28; Jn 14:6; Acts 4:12; Col. 1:17-18.

3. GRACE ALONE (*sola gratia*)

The contrary: merit of works; our merit added to Christ's.

The Bible: Eph. 2:8-10; Lk. 17:10; 'G.R.A.C.E.'; Jn. 3:16.

4. FAITH ALONE (*sola fide*) - more accurately 'faith in Christ alone', since *faith is never alone*: *good works are the fruit from the root*.

The contrary: faith + meritorious works + sacraments (7)

The Bible: Rom. 3:28 (Luther and Jas. 2:24?); Gal. 2:16;

5. THE GLORY OF GOD ALONE (*soli Deo Gloria*)

The contrary: through our efforts, we share some glory.

The Bible: Ps. 115:1; Jer. 9:23-4; 1 Cor. 1:26-31; Rom. 11:36.
